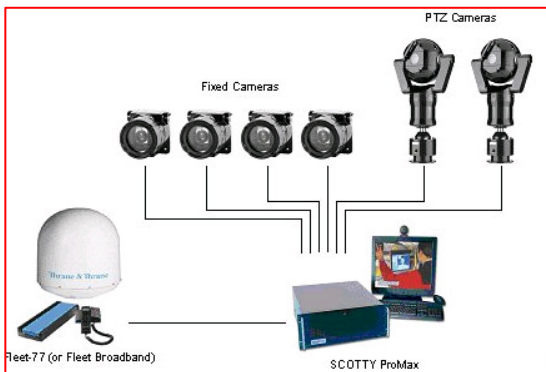

- ▶ The SCOTTY clandestine anti-piracy system extends the SCOTTY ProMax Video Communication Unit to become an international security system.
- ▶ Authorities can find out what is happening on board ship without anyone there knowing.
- ▶ Access ships underway anywhere in the world from headquarters, from other ships, even from patrolling aircraft.
- ▶ Seven cameras can be used in parallel, 48 hour permanent recording, store and forward video, live video surveillance, duplex video telephony.
- ▶ If a ship is attacked by pirates, the responding vessels can access both cameras inside and on deck of the ship in peril.
- ▶ Not only can responders see if the pirates are onboard and where, but also their numbers and weaponry.
- ▶ The condition and location of hostages can be ascertained.
- ▶ Commandoes have all of the information they need before deploying.
